The Diocese of Bardstown was founded by Pope Pius VII on April 8, 1808, along with the dioceses of Boston, New York, and Philadelphia. Only the see cities of Baltimore and New Orleans were older in rank. The Diocese of Bardstown, which moved to Louisville in 1841 and was elevated to an Archdiocese in 1937, was the first inland diocese in the nation.
