February 9-10

The see city of the Diocese of Bardstow was transferred from Bardstown to the rapidly growing port city of Louisville on February 13, 1841. At that time there were three active Catholic parishes in Louisville: St. Louis on 5th Street where Bishop Flaget lived, Our Lady's, the French parish in what is now called Portland, and St. Boniface, the German parish. The Catholic population was 4,000 out of a total population of about 21,000 in Louisville.
