On February 2, 1955, Bishop Charles Garrett Maloney was ordained as auxiliary bishop for the Archdiocese of Louisville. Bishop Maloney would serve the diocese for 50 years. Known for his business and administrative talent, Bishop Maloney was civically involved in issues of race relations and other social issues. He also was a supporter of religious liberty and modern scripture scholarship at the Second Vatican Council. Bishop Maloney died in April 2006.
